The flooding exposes systemic failures in dealing with disasters and is also a clear sign of the impact of climate change as unprecedented rain and the melting of glaciers have led to inundation. Pakistan is responsible for less than 1% of planet-warming gases but is the eighth most vulnerable country in the world to climate change.
